Detail of change

- 1. Amend citation 1.2 as follows:
- '2. Candidates will be required to present themselves for written and (if requested by the examiners) oral examinations and to submit three copies of a dissertation in a prescribed form on an approved topic as defined in (6) and (7) below.'
 - 2. Delete citation 1.9
 - 3. Amend citation 1.10 as follows:

<u>'940</u>. In order to pass the degree, a student must pass all its assessed components. Where one or more components are failed, the student will be given the opportunity to re-sit or resubmit them once, as the case may be.'
