The regulations made by the Russian and East European Studies Management Committee are as follows:

First year examinations

There will be three compulsory papers to be taken at the end of the first year of the course.

1. An examination paper on *History of Russia, the USSR and Eastern Europe in the Twentieth CenturyTwentieth Century Russian, Soviet and East European History*.

2. An examination paper on *Contemporary Russian and East European Studies Part 1.*

3. An examination paper on Contemporary Russian and East European Studies

Part 2.

Explanatory Notes

The core paper has already been advertised to students on course as 'History of Russia, the USSR and Eastern Europe in the Twentieth Century', so the change is to be made with immediate effect for 1st year MPhil students to bring the *Examination Regulations* in line.

Consideration of vested interests – All on course students were consulted regarding the proposed change and no students raised any concerns.
