**1. P.734, I.38**, after 'eight electives,' insert 'a maximum of two of which can be completed by taking (up to four) 'half' electives,'

**Explanatory Notes**

These changes are designed to allow on-course 2<sup>nd</sup> year EMBA students to take up to four 'half-electives' in place of two full electives, if they so wish.
