### Detail of change

Deletions struck-through:

<sup>1.5</sup>(1) The European Language

<sup>1.6</sup>Candidates will be required to offer:

<sup>1.7</sup>(i) Language papers in the European Language (one paper of three hours and two papers each of one-and-a-half hours including <del>in French</del> certification of attendance and participation in oral classes, as specified for the Preliminary Examination in Modern Languages).

### **Explanatory Notes**

The requirement for there to be certification of attendance and participation in oral classes had originally applied solely to French; this was extended to cover all languages from MT17, but, mistakenly, this change was not made to the associated joint schools regulations at the time. Through this change, this is now being corrected. All students doing any joint school at Prelims in 17-18 will have been referring, in addition to the global Joint Schools handbook, to the handbook for their particular language, and in each language-specific handbook was stated the requirement for oral certification for all students regardless of subject combination. Due to the timing of this correction to the regulations, it is being made for students starting from MT 2018.
