<sup>1.13</sup>6. A candidate who has failed to satisfy the examiners in any one of the examinations may enter again for that examination on one, but not more than one, subsequent occasion. <u>No candidate who has satisfied the examiners in any one of the examinations may enter again for the same examination.</u>

**Explanatory Notes** Queries have been raised regarding the ability of postgraduate taught course candidates to resit examinations if they have not failed. Amendments have been made to make explicit the fact that examinations can only be retaken if failed.
