Detail of change

Amend citation reference 1.27 as follows (new text is underlined):

4. A candidate who has failed to satisfy the examiners in the examination may enter again for the examination on one, but not more than one, subsequent occasion. <u>Unless the special regulations for the examination specify otherwise, this resit attempt shall normally be taken at the next opportunity, but may be deferred once, i.e. it must be taken at one of the next two opportunities. No candidate who has satisfied the examiners in the examination may enter again for the same examination.</u>

Explanatory Notes

Taught Degrees Panel of Education Committee decided at its meeting of 5 March 2019 that general regulations for postgraduate taught examinations should set time limits on taking resits, and that these provisions in general regulations should apply unless otherwise specified in special regulations.
