## **Detail of change**

1. Amend citation reference 1.7 as follows:

'Course 2. Candidates shall be examined in nine standard subjects. Candidates will be examined in accordance with the Examination Regulations set out below. They will also be required to spend, after their matriculation, an academic year of residence in a European university approved in accordance with these regulations, and to have attended such courses at the approved university as are approved in accordance with these regulations, and to have completed passed such examinations at the approved university as the faculty board may specify.'

- 2. Amend citation reference 1.12 as follows:
  - '4. Candidates will be required to take pass certain examinations at the approved universities. Details will be available from the Institute of European and Comparative Law.'
