- 1. Amend citation reference 1.21
- (i) Candidates will offer <u>a minimum of</u> 10 units <u>for examination but may offer further units if</u> <u>they wish, subject to the guidance in the Course handbook.</u> <u>with e One unit correspondsing to a 16 hour lecture course.</u>
- 2. Amend citation reference 1.24
- (iv) Candidates may offer one unit which is a dissertation which may count as one or two units. The dissertation will follow the guidelines and procedures of the Part C Mathematics course outlined in the Special Regulations for the Honour School of Mathematics.

Explanatory Notes

Previously the regulations stated that candidates should offer 10 units for examination, the intention of the Supervisory Committee and has always been the case that candidates should be able to offer more than 10 units if they wish. The Examination Regulations are being update to reflect current practice.

In 2017–18 students will be allowed to offer either a one-unit or a two-unit dissertation so the reference to dissertations being one-unit in weight needs to be removed.
