Amend citation 3.8 as follows:

3.8 Options: Each candidate will undertake and be assessed in two areas of Biochemistry, each selected from options approved by the Biochemistry Steering Committee, and published by the Department of Biochemistry. Two lists, each consisting of ~~three~~ at least two options, will be published and one option must be chosen from each list. The lists of options will be posted in the Department of Biochemistry and sent to Senior Tutors of all colleges not later than noon on Friday of the eighth week of Trinity Term in the year preceding that in which the examination is taken.

Explanatory Notes

It has been deemed necessary to remove one of the 6 usually offered options in Part II of the Honour School of Molecular and Cellular Biochemistry to be taken by candidates in 2018-19 academic year, due to the option organiser being on sabbatical. The department decided against devising a replacement option as the entire course in Molecular and Cellular Biochemistry has recently entered a period of a comprehensive review with a view to being significantly re-designed.
