[1.2] 2 Candidates may be permitted under certain circumstances to suspend status for a maximum of two years.

[1.3] to [1.9] $\frac{3-2}{2}$ Every candidate will be required to satisfy the examiners in the following:

- i. Attendance at a minimum of 80% of face to face classes, attendance at the day schools, a summer school and at six tutorials;
- # <u>i.</u> Four written papers, two on each of the topics below, each of three hours' duration:

a Early Modern Literature b Victorian and Modern Literature

iii <u>ii.</u> Two portfolios of written work demonstrating critical approaches to language and literature, the first to be of not more than 3,000 words and the second to be of not more than 5,000 words;

iv iii. Thirteen Twelve coursework essays, each of not more than 2,000 words in length.
