**Detail of change**

Amend citation reference 1.7. Inserted text has been underlined.

7. Candidates may be permitted under certain circumstances to suspend status for a maximum of six terms. When a student is entered as a candidate in an examination following return from suspension of status within six terms of the term in which they were originally due to be examined, they shall be entitled to be examined in accordance with the regulations pertaining at the time at which they received teaching for the examination.

**Explanatory Notes**

At its Trinity Term 2015 meeting, Examinations Panel agreed that candidates for the FHS should be entitled to be assessed according to the regulations that were in force at the time they were taught, for up to six terms after the original assessment date, without needing to seek special permission from Education Committee, and that candidates for other examinations should have an equivalent entitlement. Due to an administrative oversight which is now being corrected, changes were not made at the time to the regulations for the Bachelor of Theology.
