Detail of change

^{1.11}11. The examiners may award a distinction for excellence in the whole examination. A candidate who fails any one of the four elements of the examination (i.e. one of the three essays or the thesis) may apply to retake that element either in the September immediately following the examination, or in the year immediately following the failed examination, in line with the normal assessment submission timetable for the course. ~~A candidate who fails two or more elements may retake the examination in the year immediately following the failed examination.~~ It is necessary for a candidate to retake only the failed elements of the examination. No resubmitted essay or thesis can receive a mark of more than 60.

Explanatory Notes

Modification to the possible options for retaking an examination, and a specification of the highest mark awardable for a retaken examination. This brings the regulation in line with practice as specified at the start of the academic year 2015-16 in the handbook for the course and in the Examination Conventions.
