- "3. Transfer to DPhil, or MLitt or MSc by Research status"
- 2. Amend citation 1.27 as follows:

"The thesis must not exceed 80,000 words for the DPhil, <del>or</del>-50,000 words for the MLitt, <u>or 40,000 words for the MSc by Research</u>, the limit to include abstract, all notes and appendices, but not the bibliography. Any thesis exceeding this limit is liable to be rejected."
