1. Amend citation reference. 1.32 as follows (new text underlined, deleted text struck through):

⁶2. Assignments and written reports on projects must be presented not later than the time and date stipulated for each exercise; these will be published by the BSG Graduate Studies Committee before the first Monday of each term in which the assignment or project must be undertaken. For all modules except Core III: The Politics of Policymaking, and Core IV: Science and Public Policy and the Summer Project the required number of copies must be delivered to the Examination Schools, and addressed to the Chair of Examiners for the Master of Public Policy, c/o Examination Schools, High Street, Oxford. The assignments for Core III: The Politics of Policymaking, and Core IV: Science and Public Policy and the Summer IV: Science and Public Policy and the Summer Schools, High Street, Oxford. The assignments for Core III: The Politics of Policymaking, and Core IV: Science and Public Policy and the Summer Project will be submitted electronically via WebLearn only.'
