4. The assessment shall consist of (a) written examinations and (b) course assignments. Candidates must satisfy the examiners in the assessment associated with each component. Modes of assessment and submission dates will be published by one of the Directors of the M.Sc. in Taxation and distributed to all candidates in the first week of the Michaelmas Term of the academic year in which the assessment takes place. All course assignments shall be submitted electronically. On submitting the assignments, candidates will also be required to submit an online declaration of authorship. Candidates will be contacted with details of how to submit the assignments.
