Detail of change

1. Amend 1.15 as follows:

'10.Each candidate shall be required to submit a dissertation of not more than 15,000 words (excluding abstract, references <u>bibliography</u> and appendices) on a subject approved by the supervisor. The candidate shall send to the Standing Committee, with the written approval of his or her supervisor, the proposed title of the dissertation for consideration by the Standing Committee, by noon on the Friday of the second week of Hilary Term in the academic year in which his or her name was entered on the Register of M.Sc. Students.'

2. Amend citation 1.16 as follows:

'11.The dissertation (three two copies) must be typewritten and delivered to the Examination Schools, High Street, Oxford, not later than noon on Thursday of eighth week of Trinity Term in the year in which the examination is taken.'
