1. Amend citation 1.2 as follows:

'2. Candidates will be required to present themselves for examination in the compulsory paper in Themes in African History and the Social Sciences <u>in Trinity Term.</u>, and in one optional paper at the end of Trinity Term in the year of registration. In addition, each candidate will be required to submit the following written work:'
