^{1.56}14.20. A candidate may not withdraw once all parts of an Examination have been completed. they have attempted or presented themselves for all parts of the Examination.

Explanatory Notes

A minor change is being made to the regulations relating to withdrawal from Examinations to clarify that it is not possible to withdrawn from an Examination (e.g. FPE, FHS, MSt) once all assessment for that Examination has been attempted, including any papers where a candidate attended but left before answering all questions.
