^{1.6}1. Each candidate shall offer the following ~~elements~~:

^{1.7}~~I-VI Six papers from the following options, of which at least one must be taken from each of A, B and C, and no more than one from F. At least two of the six papers must be archaeological (from B and D), and at least two must be historical (from C and E), unless a language paper is taken, as this can replace one of the archaeological or historical requirements.~~

I An option from List A

II An option from List B

III An option from List C

IV An option from Lists B, D or F*

V An option from Lists C, E or F*

VI Any other option from Lists A-E

VII A site or museum report

*No more than one language option from List F may be taken

Explanatory Notes

No change to syllabus. Wording of rules on valid combinations of options revised to avoid ambiguity and to prevent possible misinterpretation by students and tutors.
