# **Student Numbers 2009**

### Introduction

Student statistics tables for 2008–9 are now available on the Academic Administration Division Web site (www.admin.ox.ac.uk/sr/—click on 'Student Statistics' on the left of the page).

The statistics provide an overview of the student body based on a 'snapshot' taken on 1 December 2008, and allow comparison with the previous two years. The same 'snapshot' forms the basis of the Higher Education Student Early Statistics return (www.hefce.ac.uk/learning/datacoll/heses/) and the Student Number Planning Exercise, but with some small criteria differences. These are explained on the Web site.

This supplement contains only the high-level overviews of the student population. The full set of tables and charts are on the Web site, in the following categories:

- Ethnicity, programme type and division



The reports are based on data from the Oracle Student Systems (OSS) and also include data on Continuing Education (OUDCE), which are not held in OSS.
