Amend citation references 1.3 and 1.9 as follows:

<sup>1.2</sup>Candidates shall be examined in three areas:

<sup>1.3</sup>1. Every candidate shall ~~shall~~ be examined in writing during the Trinity term of their first year and will offer four papers of three hours each, as follows:

<sup>1.4</sup>Paper (1) Introduction to world archaeology.

<sup>1.5</sup>Paper (2) Introduction to anthropological theory.

<sup>1.6</sup>Paper (3) Perspectives on human evolution.

<sup>1.7</sup>Paper (4) The nature of archaeological and anthropological enquiry.

<sup>1.8</sup>2. All candidates will be required to undertake a course of practical work, including laboratory work.

~~<sup>1.9</sup>All candidates will be assessed on their practical ability.~~

<sup>1.10</sup>Class co-ordinators shall make available to the chair of the examiners records showing the extent to which each candidate has pursued an adequate course of practical work.
