### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1.95: Bringing text in line with University terminology.
- <u>Czech (with Slovak):</u> Both changes reduce the amount of teaching required for this paper and should ensure fewer single-student tutorials. The reduction to a selection of two authors brings Czech into line with other languages, allowing the papers to be easily taught in a single term of tutorials.
- <u>Portuguese</u>: Better integration with other texts, given theoretical/comparative dimension of this paper.
