Candidates will be contacted with details of how to collect or access the question paper. Essays should be typed in double-spacing and should conform to the standards of academic presentation prescribed in the 'Guidelines for writers of Theses' in the course handbook. Essays shall normally be written during the Michaelmas Term in the year of examination and must be submitted not later than 12 noon on the Friday before the beginning of nought week of Hilary Full

Term of the year of examination. Each essay must be accompanied by a formal declaration confirming that the essay is the candidate's own work. The University's regulations on Late Submission of Work will apply.
