Foundation Undergraduate Certificate in English Literature

The course shall consist of lectures, classes and tutorials on the subject of English Literature. The course is available on a part-time basis only over a period of two years.

2 Every candidate will be required to satisfy the examiners in the following:

<u>i.</u> Four written papers, two on each of the topics below,

a Early Modern Literature b Victorian and Modern Literature

ii. Two portfolios of written work demonstrating critical approaches to language and literature, the first to be of not more than 3,000 words and the second to be of not more than 5,000 words;

iii. Eleven coursework essays, each of not more than 2,000 words in length.

The portfolios and assignments under 2 ii and iii will be submitted via the approved online submission system to the examiners for consideration by such dates as the examiners shall determine and shall notify candidates. by the dates published in the course handbooks at the start of each academic year.

3 Candidates may, at the discretion of the examiners, be required to attend a viva voce examination at the end of the course of studies.

4-3 Candidates who fail to satisfy the examiners in the assessed work specified clause 2 may be permitted to resubmit work in respect of the part or parts of th examination which they have failed on not more than one occasion which shall normal be within one year of the initial failure.
