Amend citations as follows:

^{1.20}(a) A thesis of not more than 30,000 words (excluding bibliography but including footnotes and appendices) on a topic approved by the MPhil Teaching Committee, to which the Graduate Studies Committee delegates this function. The thesis must be on a topic in the general field of development studies. The topic of the thesis must be chosen in consultation with and with the approval of the candidate's supervisor. If a separate thesis supervisor is required, ~~he or she~~ **they** must have agreed to undertake the supervision prior to the approval of the topic as specified above. The thesis must be uploaded to the University approved online assessment platform not later than the Friday of the first week of the Trinity Full Term in which the examination is to be taken.
