## **Details of Change:**

Amend citation 1.14 as follows:

1.14 (a) Offer a thesis of not more than 30,000 words, including footnotes and appendices. An electronic copy of the thesis must be submitted via the University approved online assessment platform by noon on the Monday of week 5 of Trinity Term in the second year of the course. Only the file submitted via the University approved online assessment platform constitutes a valid submission; no concomitant hard-copy may be submitted. The submission must be anonymous, and the submission must be accompanied by a declaration indicating that it is the candidate's own work. Successful candidates will be required to deposit one copy of their thesis in the Bodleian Library, and will be required to sign a form stating whether they will permit their thesis to be consulted.
