Detail of change

^{1.40}7. If it is the opinion of the examiners that the work done by a candidate is not of sufficient merit to qualify them for the degree of MPhil but is nevertheless of sufficient merit to qualify them for the Degree of Master of Studies in Linguistics, Philology and Phonetics, the candidate shall be given the option of re-sitting the MPhil examination under the appropriate regulation or of being granted permission to supplicate for the Degree of Master of Studies.

^{1.41}8. Each candidate is required to present themselves for an oral examination if and when required by the examiners.

~~4.44~~8. ^{1.42}9. Candidates requesting re-examination should be required to re-sit or resubmit any unit of assessment in which they have failed to achieve a pass mark. The highest mark awarded for a re-examined unit of assessment should be the pass mark.

Explanatory Notes

In the process of editing the regulations, the requirement for candidates to undertake an oral examination was removed in error. This change reinstates this requirement.
