Detail of change

Remove citation 1.9:

6. The examiners shall retain one copy of each dissertation of each successful candidate for electronic deposit in the Radcliffe Science Library.

Amend citations 1.10-1.13 as follows:

7-6. Candidates must pass each assessment in order to pass the examination overall.

8 <u>7</u>. Candidates who have failed any assessment at second attempt will be deemed to have failed the requirements of the MSc.

9 <u>8</u>. Candidates who have failed the requirement of the MSc but have satisfied the requirements for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma (all the requirements for the MSc, except completion of the dissertation) may be awarded the Postgraduate Diploma.

<u>10 9</u>. Candidates who have satisfied the requirements for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma (all the requirements for the MSc, except completion of the dissertation) and who do not wish to continue their studies, may end their registration and at that point be awarded the Postgraduate Diploma.
