**[1.1]** 1. Before admission to the course, candidates must either have taken a degree in Chinese in the Honour School of ~~Oriental~~ Asian and Middle Eastern Studies at Oxford or a comparable degree from another university, or must otherwise satisfy the Board of the Faculty ~~Oriental~~ Asian and Middle Eastern Studies that they possess the necessary qualifications in the Chinese language to profit by the course.

**[1.2]** 2. Every candidate must follow for at least three terms a course of instruction in Chinese Studies.

**[1.3]** 3. Syllabus There will be four Units.

**[1.4]** 4. Unit (i) Prescribed texts, with special reference to a subject approved by the Board. This is a written examination paper.

**[1.5]** 5. Unit (ii) Either Classical Chinese unprepared translation or Japanese or another Asian language approved by the Board. This is a written examination paper. Candidates may choose a language other than Classical Chinese only if the Board is satisfied that they possess a good knowledge of Classical Chinese. Candidates who have taken Chinese in the Honour School of ~~Oriental~~ Asian and Middle Eastern Studies at Oxford are required to take Japanese or another Asian language.
