In each year of Part 2, full-time students must submit or be examined in at least two papers by the end of Hilary Full term, at least two papers by the end of Trinity Full term and the remainder of papers for the year by the Long Vacation submission deadline. Part-time students must submit three papers in each year of Part 2 with at least one paper by the end of Hilary Full term each year, at least one paper by the end of Trinity Full term each year and the remaining papers for the year by the Long Vacation submission deadline. exact dates will be published in the course handbook at the beginning of each academic year. The sole exception to the submission requirements is that, where a part-time student is submitting a paper under Section E, in that academic year they can submit their Section E paper at either the Trinity Term or the Long Vacation submission deadline. The two exceptions to this requirements requirement are as follows:

- 1. Where a part-time student is submitting a paper under Section E, in that academic year they can submit their Section E paper at either the Trinity Term or the Long Vacation submission deadline;
- 2. Where a part-time student is, additionally, taking a language as their sole other requirement in that year, they may submit the paper under Section E by either the Hilary or the Long Vacation submission deadline.

12. Candidates who fail to satisfy the examiners in the written work or the examinations
under 10. will be permitted to resubmit work in respect of the paper or papers which they
have failed, on not more than one occasion, which shall normally be within one year of the
initial failure.
